As a British Fencing Official It is not your responsibility to decide whether or not a child is being abused.....but it is your responsibility to act if you have any concerns.

This 3-hour workshop is an excellent opportunity to learn and understand more about the sensitive and important subject of protecting children and young people from abuse and how to handle situations in the workplace. This workshop will help you, whether the Coach / Official / Club Welfare officer / volunteer or parent of a fencer.

-  Identify good coaching practice to promote a positive relationship with children
-  Identify sport situations and coaching practice that might constitute either poor practice or possible abuse
-  Identify ways of dealing with your own feelings about child abuse
-  Recognise the signs and symptoms of abuse and appreciate why reporting it is so difficult
-  Identify appropriate action if abuse is suspected
-  Identify appropriate action if a child discloses he/she has been abused
-  Describe appropriate practice that reduces the likelihood of abuse occurring
